(IA Case# 11-033, Conformance to Laws) Assault

On April 2011, Chief of Police directed this office to conduct an investigation regarding a police officer who was arrested for Assault and Family Violence.

Information from the preliminary report indicated that the allege officer was arrested for assaulting a female individual who was known to him. The female individual was also arrested regarding this case.

Internal Affairs investigation revealed that On April 2011, the allege officer got into an argument with his common law wife while at their residence. Argument started when the officer called the common law wife to go inside the house. She did not comply right away and decided to continue what she was doing. When she returned back to the house an argument ensued and during the argument they both sustained injuries from the altercation. Photographs revealed the injuries by both individuals as claimed on their statements. Based on the physical injuries sustained by both individual they were arrested for Assault and Family Violence.

This investigation of Conformance To Law "Assault" against this officer was "Sustained". The officer voluntarily resigned from the department. The chief of Police accepted the resignation. Case was filed for records.
