IA Case # 11-032 (Conformance to Laws) Criminal Sexual Conduct

On March 18, 2011, The Chief of Police initiated a complaint of “Conformance to Laws (Criminal Sexual Conduct)” against an officer. It was alleged that the officer had committed a criminal act against a family member.

A family member of the officer alleged that the officer had committed a criminal act on two separate occasions. Because of the sensitivity of this issue, the investigation was coordinated along with the Criminal Investigation Section.

Evidence obtained during this investigation later revealed that the allegation against the officer was false and was dismissed during court proceedings.

The allege violation against the officer was “not sustained”. The officer was issued a letter of clearance by the Chief of Police.
