### **(Case# 11-022, Unsatisfactory Performance)**

On February, 2011, Chief of Police Filed a complaint of Unsatisfactory Performance with Internal Affairs against an officer assigned to Neighborhood Patrol Division.

On February, 2011, it was alleged that an officer failed to take a report of a crime that was being reported.

The complainant on this case went to a Precinct to file a case against an individual who was committing a crime against a family member. The parents talked to the allege officer explaining the nature of the crime. The officer also talked to the victim and advised the victim what to do. The officer did not obtain a case number.

Investigation by Internal Affairs revealed that the complainant did met with the allege officer. There was a service number obtained assigned to the allege officer. The complainant was not satisfied so they reported it to another precinct and got a case number. The allege violation being reported by the complainant is a valid complaint therefore the Internal Affairs Investigation of "Unsatisfactory Performance" was SUSTAINED against the allege officer.

During this investigation it also revealed that supervisor of the allege officer was also in violation of "Unsatisfactory Performance" therefore he was cited on this case.

Case is closed and filed for records.
